## From Your Editor

### Hi Fellow Eagles,

The heat of summer is upon us and it has been pretty oppressive this year. The yearly fly-in was a great success as we made nearly \$700. It was a great day of flying and everyone had a good time.

The roof of the pavilion has needed attention for a while now. We were just going to replace bad shingles but after inspecting the roof, we found more bad shingles than good ones which made a new roof a necessity. At the work party before the fly-in we had most of the members who come to meetings in attendance and we voted to put a new roof on the pavilion. I had gotten an estimate of @ \$363 for material and another estimate of \$300 to install it. The work was completed on Sunday the 31st of July. Total cost of the project was \$683 which included paying the cost of gas to deliver the material to the field. See picture below.
